Tree roses are not winter-hardy in Utah. They must be protected during the winter. Wrap or cover them carefully..

Planting Instructions:

1. Dig a hole twice as large as the pot. Mix one-third **Gardener's Gold Rose Planting Mix** with two-thirds soil from the hole. Add 1/4 cup **Dr. Earth Starter Fertilizer** into the soil mixture.
2. Cut the sides of the pot in four places before setting the pot in the hole.
3. Set the pot in the hole at the proper depth. The bud union should be at ground level, or slightly below ground level.
4. Remove the sides of the pot. If the soil is loose in the pot be careful not to remove the plant or break the soil away from its roots.
5. **You do not have to remove the bottom of the pot; just be sure to remove the sides.**
6. Fill the hole with the soil, fertilizer and mulch mixture. Water the plant thoroughly. Make as much mud around the plant as possible, you cannot water your new plant too much.
7. Make a large basin around each plant; large enough to hold at least one gallon of water.
8. If planting roses early in the spring, before the danger of frost is past, mound 2" to 6" of soil over the canes after planting and watering. Leave this mound until the buds form, then remove the extra soil.
9. Mix 2 ounces of **J&L Root Starter** in one gallon of water. Pour a half gallon of the Root Starter Mixture around each rose bush at planting time. Repeat this liquid fertilizer every two weeks for two months.
10. Keep the plants moist, but don't keep them too wet, all summer.
11. Prune and *deadhead* roses as needed during the summer to keep them blooming their best.

Rose Classifications

Hybrid teas They have long, narrow buds that open into large blooms with one blossom on each stem. They bloom throughout the growing season in a wide range of colors. The upright plants grow three feet or taller.

Floribundas They are usually shorter than hybrid tea roses and often bloom more freely. Floribunda roses bear great quantities of flower clusters on medium length stems throughout the summer.

Grandifloras have the best qualities of hybrid teas and floribundas. The upright bushes usually grow quite tall, reaching five to six feet. The flowers are in clusters on long stems. They are hardy and bloom continuously.

Miniatures are tiny versions of the other types of roses and generally grow less than two feet tall. The blossoms are smaller than other roses, but they are very attractive. Miniatures are hardy and are excellent for edgings or mass plantings.

English Garden Roses They are hybrids from crossing old garden roses with modern bush roses. They are very fragrant and have a unique flower form that adds a new look to the garden. They generally grow 3 to 6 feet tall and are great for fencelines and hedges. Many varieties bloom repeatedly all summer while others only bloom in the spring and fall.

Antique Roses These roses are some of the oldest varieties of roses that are still propagated. They make outstanding landscape shrubs that usually grow 4 to 6 feet tall. They are fragrant and provide something different for the yard.

Groundcover Roses are an alternative to the common plants used for groundcovers in the yard. They grow 1 to 3 feet tall and give some fast cover for slopes or large areas. They have spectacular blossoms in the late spring and require very little maintenance. Some varieties will bloom all summer.

Climbing Roses Roses are not true climbers, like ivy or other vines. They have long arching canes that must be attached to supports such as trellises, arbors, posts, or fences. Large flower climbers have thick, stiff canes that can get 10 feet or longer. They bloom several times during the summer. Ramblers have long, thin canes with clus-

ters of small flowers that bloom once in the late spring or early summer.

Shrub or hedge roses Shrub roses are broad spreading roses that are great for backgrounds or borders. They grow 4' to 10' tall with numerous canes and thick foliage. Flowers can be single or double. Flowers are borne at the ends of the canes or in branches along the canes. Some varieties flower once in the spring while other varieties flower continuously. Shrub roses produce abundant rose hips after flowering.

Tree Roses A tree rose can be any rose that is grafted on a straight, sturdy trunk. Trunks may be one to two feet high for miniature roses or three to four feet high for hybrid tea roses. All tree roses require careful pruning and special winter protection in this area.

AARS Winning Roses - Each year rose seedlings are evaluated in nationwide trial grounds for a 2-year period. Official All-America Rose Selections Test Gardens are located throughout the U.S., each with its own judge. The best performers are designated as AARS Award Winners and are promoted with the **AARS Symbol**.
